ORDINANCE 01-17

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF A FISCAL OFFICER, REPEALING ORDINANCE 08-16 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY;**

WHEREAS, Section 733.262 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the Mayor to appoint a Village Fiscal Officer ("Fiscal Officer"), subject to the approval of the Village Council, and

WHEREAS, Mayor Gilliland has appointed Leslie K. DeVico to the position of Fiscal Officer.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;**

Section 1. That Council hereby approves the appointment of Leslie K. DeVico to the position of Fiscal Officer.

Section 2. That the Fiscal Officer shall have all those powers, duties, and functions as provided by the laws of the State of Ohio, as well as all of the following;

- A. The Fiscal Officer shall attend all Council Meetings and Council Committee Meetings and shall keep a record of those proceedings and of all the rules, bylaws, resolutions and ordinances passed or adopted; and
- B. The Fiscal Officer shall attend training programs, as provided by law and as authorized by the Mayor; and
- C. The Fiscal Officer shall perform all the duties provided for by law for a Village Clerk and Treasurer, and other duties consistent with those offices; and
- D. The Fiscal Officer shall perform other tasks and assignments not inconsistent with the position as directed from time to time by the Mayor.

Section 3. That the Fiscal Officer shall be a salaried employee and a Professional, Overtime Exempt employee for FLSA purposes. The Fiscal Officer may earn, use, and be compensated for compensatory time at the discretion of the Mayor, subject to the terms and conditions provided in the Village of Lithopolis Policies and Procedures Manual then in effect.

Section 4. That the Fiscal Officer shall receive standard pay and full time employee benefits as provided in the Village's Benefits and Pay ordinances, as the same may be amended from time to time.

Section 5. That Ordinance 08-16 is hereby repealed.

~~Section 6. That this Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and for the further reason to have the Fiscal Officer position fully staffed, so the obligations of the Village may be timely paid, wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage.~~
