AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND APPROVING THE AMENDED 2017 APPROPRIATIONS BUDGET FOR THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 05-17 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village is required to make Appropriations for Fiscal Year 2017, and

WHEREAS, the Village may adjust line items up or down during the fiscal year in order to meet its financial obligations, and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer has certified the funds are available for appropriations for 2017, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. Council hereby repeals Ordinance 05-17.

Section 2. Council adopts and approves the Appropriations for Fiscal Year 2017; attachment A and incorporated herein, specifically:

Reduce	5201-590-0000 Other-Charges for Services	\$50,000.00
Reduce	5201-842-0000 Capital Contributions- Tap Fees	\$45,000.00
Increase	5201-549-500 Sewer Fund by	\$95,000.00

Reduce 5201-842-0000 Capital Contributions- Tap Fees \$170,000.00
(Projected Revenue Not Received)

Increase	\$50,000.00 of unappropriated funds from 1000-910-910-0000	
Increase	\$70,000.00 of unappropriated funds from Sewer Fund	
Increase	5201-549-500 Sewer Fund by	\$120,000.00

Section 3. Council directs the Fiscal Officer to forward the Fund Balances and Appropriations to the Fairfield County Auditor.

Section 4. This Ordinance, being an appropriation for the expenses of the municipal corporation, shall be in full force and effective immediately upon passage and signing by the Mayor.
