ORDINANCE 09-17

AN ORDINANCE PERMITTING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO RESIDE OUTSIDE THE VILLAGE.

WHEREAS, Section 733.262 of the Ohio Revised Code provides, "the Fiscal Officer shall become a resident of the Village within six months after the appointment takes effect, unless an Ordinance is passed approving the Fiscal Officer's residence outside of the Village"; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer is not an employee whose immediate presence is required in response to emergencies or disasters that may occur in the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council wishes to eliminate the residency requirement for the Fiscal Officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. That Council hereby finds and determines that it is unnecessary and provides no benefit to th Village to require the Fiscal Officer to be a resident of the Village of Lithopolis.

Section 2. That, pursuant to ORC Section 733.262, Council hereby approves the Fiscal Officer's residence outside of the Village.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force at the earliest time permitted by law.
