ORDINANCE 24-17

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE TEMPORARY POSITION OF FISCAL OFFICER TRAINEE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer has indicated her intent to resign in the near future; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of better administration of Village affairs to ensure the smooth transition to a new Fiscal Officer, and

WHEREAS, it is the judgment of this Council that the interests of the citizens of the Village will be better served through the creation of a Fiscal Officer Trainee position,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. That Council hereby creates the full time position of Fiscal Officer Trainee, an FLSA non-exempt position. The Fiscal Officer Trainee shall receive wages at the rate of \$18.81 per hour, and shall receive all the customary employee benefits offered to Village employees.

Section 2. That the position of Fiscal Officer Trainee shall be filled by a candidate agreed to by the Mayor,

Section 3. That the work hours of the Fiscal Officer Trainee shall be determined, and varied as appropriate, by the Fiscal Officer, and the position shall report directly to the Fiscal Officer. The Fiscal Officer Trainee may work 40 hours per week at the sole discretion of the Fiscal Officer. The Fiscal Officer Trainee position shall terminate no later than three months from the effective date of this Ordinance, and the selected candidate shall not thereafter be employed in such position.

Section 4. That the Fiscal Officer will train the Fiscal Officer Trainee in the tasks and responsibilities of the Fiscal Officer and may, in the course of such training, progressively transfer, at the Fiscal Officer's sole discretion, certain responsibilities, and work-load to the Fiscal Officer Trainee.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and for the further reason to facilitate the training of a potential Fiscal Officer in anticipation of the impending resignation of the current Fiscal Officer, wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage.
