Reminders:

The sanitary sewer pumps in 340 back yards in Lithopolis cost over \$1,000.00 each to replace. Pump failures occur when inappropriate materials are flushed. Items that should NEVER be flushed:

- Grease
- Feminine Hygiene Products
- Q-Tips
- Disposable wipes of any kind

These items will cause pump failure. Homeowners may be held financially accountable for these premature failures when the pumps are clogged with debris. The greatest damage is caused by “disposable wipes”.

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With the mild temperatures, residents have been able to get out, clean and rake their yards when we should be shoveling snow this time of year! As a reminder, leaves cannot be blown or raked into the streets and snow cannot be shoveled into the streets. Also, no open burning of leaves is permitted. It is a violation of law and subject to citations and fines.

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Bulk pick-up or excessive amounts of trash for Rumpke must be called in to the Village office at 614-837-2031 at least 24 hours in advance. Television sets cannot exceed 32 inches and any mattresses or upholstered furniture must be covered in disposable plastic prior to pick-up. 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Message from the Village of Lithopolis Zoning Inspector: All resident concerns regarding the Sign Ordinance, Lighting Ordinance, Housing and Property Maintenance Ordinance must be reported to the Village Zoning Inspector. An investigation shall commence only by written or oral complaint with the complainant identified. All records pertaining to the identification of a complainant shall be kept with the record of inspections and notice of violation in regard to any structure or premises, shall be public record and available upon request.

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R.I.T.A.:

What are the due dates for estimated municipal income taxes?

Estimated payments are due quarterly as follows:

1st Quarter - On or before the fifteenth day of the fourth month after the beginning of each fiscal year.

2nd Quarter - On or before the fifteenth day of the sixth month after the beginning of the taxable year.

3rd Quarter - On or before the fifteenth day of the ninth month after the beginning of the taxable year.

4th Quarter - On or before the fifteenth day of the twelfth month of the taxable year.
