A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS ADOPTING THE 2017 FAIRFIELD COUNTY NATURAL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN.

WHEREAS, The Federal Emergency Management Agency is the federal agency in charge of the Mitigation Program for the United States of America, and that Agency has directed that local jurisdictions, which may be eligible to participate in mitigation funding in the future, must participate in a County-wide Mitigation Program, and,

WHEREAS, The Ohio Emergency Management Agency is the state agency that oversees the mitigation program with the State of Ohio and is the agency directly involved with the County Emergency Management Agency for mitigation activities, and,

WHEREAS, The Fairfield County Office of Emergency Management and Homeland Security is charged with developing a County Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan for Fairfield County which includes all jurisdictions, and,


WHEREAS, The Fairfield County Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan must include the Cities and Villages of the County, and those jurisdictions must adopt the FEMA approved plan in order to be covered under the plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. The Village of Lithopolis does hereby adopt the Fairfield County Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan as written by the Fairfield County Office of Emergency Management and Homeland Security and as approved by Region IV of FEMA.

Section 2. That this Resolution will be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.


