POLICE BLOTTER-August 2017

On August 1, a resident reported that a neighbor threatened to unleash his dog on her children for being too loud. The neighbor was advised by police of the consequences of making such threats.

On August 9, a resident reported that someone had entered their garage and removed belongings from their car.

On August 9, police took a report of vandalism resulting in substantial damage. Two juveniles were identified as being responsible and were charged in Juvenile Court.

On August 9, police took reports from vehicle owners concerning property that was removed from their vehicles. The two juveniles who were responsible for the vandalism were also charged in the thefts.

On August 15, police responded with medics on a suicide attempt. A resident had taken several painkillers because of depression. She was transported to the hospital for medical treatment and a mental health evaluation.

On August 18, police responded to a residence regarding an unruly juvenile. The juvenile suffers from mental health issues and on this occasion assaulted two family pets. The juvenile was advised of the consequences of her behavior.

On August 20, police responded to a party where a guest had become intoxicated and was trying to assault other guests. She was arrested for Disorderly Conduct and was transported to jail.

On August 23, police responded to a shoplifting report at a local business. The clerk supplied the officers with a description of the suspect and the license plate of the vehicle he left in. Officers located the vehicle and the suspect, who was charged with Theft.

On August 24, police responded to a barking dog complaint. Due to the fact that officers have been dispatched several times to the same address concerning their dog, the owner was cited for the offense.

On August 24, police stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation. It was determined that neither occupant had driving privileges, and the officer detected the odor of marijuana in the car. A subsequent search turned up a handgun, ammunition for an AR15 style weapon, suspected methamphetamine, marijuana, and baggies designed for distribution. It was also

discovered that the passenger was a gang member from San Bernadino, California. Both occupants were arrested and transported to jail.

On August 28,it was discovered that a Mayor's Court defendant had an active warrant for his arrest from Reynoldsburg. Following the disposition of his case, he was arrested and transported to Reynoldsburg Police.

On August 29,a resident reported seeing a person making several trips getting water from a neighbor's outdoor spigot. The resident took pictures of the person and his vehicle. Police located the suspect doing construction in another area of the neighborhood, and he admitted to taking the water. He was issued a summons for Theft after it was determined he did not have permission of the homeowner.

On August 30, police responded to the report of an unruly juvenile being restrained by a parent. The juvenile was angry over being called names by other children in the neighborhood. He was able to be calmed down by officers.
