POLICE BLOTTER-February 2017

**On February 6,** an officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for an equipment violation. The officer detected the odor of burnt marijuana and conducted a search. A device used for ingesting marijuana was discovered, along with residue. The motorist was cited for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

**On February 7,** police responded to the report of a house fire. The house sustained heavy damage as a result.

**On February 12,** an officer observed a male pull on the parking lot of a closed business. The officer investigated and discovered the male to be intoxicated. He was placed under arrest and transported to jail. The male was recently released from prison for murder, in which he shot and killed another man during a robbery.

**On February 13,** police responded to the report of a vehicle crash. A motorist traveled into the left lane and attempted to make a left turn onto an intersecting street. The vehicle then struck another vehicle after turning. The motorist was cited.

**On February 13,** police responded to a residence in regards to discovering a threatening note directed at their young daughter. It was determined that their grade school age son wrote the note.

**On February 16,** police responded to a hit skip accident. It was determined that the accident happened several weeks previously and there was no information on the other vehicle.

**On February 18,** an officer stopped a vehicle for speeding and discovered the operator had an outstanding warrant. He was cited for speed and transported to Franklin County Jail.

**On February 19,** police were dispatched to a residence in regard to a stolen vehicle. The resident stated she had loaned a car to a person who had not returned it, but did not want to file charges. The officer took a report and advised the resident to call back if they decided to file charges.

**On February 20,** police responded to a residential burglary. The residence was entered through a rear window and several pieces of jewelry and a firearm were stolen. Police are currently investigating.

**On February 24,** police responded to a breaking and entering of an outbuilding. A neighbor scared off two males, but was not able to provide detailed information about their appearance. The resident returned and reported no items appeared to be missing.

**On February 25,** a resident reported seeing a person park in front of his house and attempt to gain entry into another vehicle. After trying unsuccessfully, the male left the area.
