Subject to the rules and regulations governing the Village of Lithopolis Public Works Department and all ordinances and laws pertaining thereto, in force now or in the further, the undersigned, as owner/tenant of the premises herein described, hereby make application for utility service at premises known on the records of the Lithopolis Public Works Department as:

Applicant hereby agrees to be responsible for all utility usage on or about the premises and to make prompt payments of all utility charges incurred at the premises. Applicant further agrees that the utility charges incurred shall be paid in full on or before the 15th day of each month or on the fifteenth day after the billing date, whichever is later. Delinquent utility charges shall be subject to a penalty as determined by Council. Unpaid utility charges may make the service address subject to termination of service after a 10 (ten) day notice. To have service restored, applicant/owner must pay the delinquent charges, any penalties and interest along with a \$50.00 reconnection charge. _____ **Initial**

Owner and tenant agree that the owner is liable for all unpaid utility charges by the tenant. The Village retains the right to collect unpaid utility charges as it sees fit including, but not limited to, assessments, liens, collection companies, civil court actions, and reports to credit services. _____ **Initial**

Owner and tenant further agree that should the premises be sold or the tenant changes, the owner and the tenant shall notify the Lithopolis Public Works Department and arrange for the prorating of unpaid utility charges and penalties. Owner and applicant agree to notify the Lithopolis Public Works Department of any change of address. _____ **Initial**

Water Availability Charge shall be assessed to each and every platted and separately addressed or numbered parcel of land within the corporation limits of the Village and to all users located outside the municipal limits of the Village. **The WAC (Water Availability Charge) is the responsibility of the land or homeowner, and not of a tenant.** Per Ordinance 19-08 which was enacted November 14, 2008. _____ **Initial**

Tenant/Renters may be responsible as the primary billed for water and sewer use service. Owner may be responsible as the primary billed for water and sewer use service. Owner shall be responsible for Trash, Storm Water, WAC (Water Availability Charge), if applicable.
