Sanitary Sewers

The sanitary sewer pumps, which are in 340 back yards in Lithopolis, cost over \$1,000.00 each to replace. Failures often occur when inappropriate materials are being flushed.

Items you should NEVER flush are:

- Grease
- Feminine Hygiene Products
- Q-tips
- Wipes of Any Kind

All of these items will

cause pump failure. Homeowners may be held financially accountable for these premature failures when the pumps are clogged with debris.

The worst culprit of this are the "Disposable Wipes, they are not to be flushed into the Village Sewer System!

Please help us avoid this unnecessary waste of taxpayer's dollars.
