Permits

Permits are required by Village Code. Permits and inspections are required for the protection of public health, safety and welfare. The Village inspection staff enforces adopted codes to assure that the construction is safe and in compliance. Projects not built to Village standards may have a negative impact on the sale of your home and on insurance costs. A building permit is required when the project involves

new construction, alterations or an addition to your building. Additional projects that **require** a permit include, but not limited to, new or replacement of the following:

- * Plumbing or Electrical Systems
- * Electrical Outlets and Fixtures
- * Garages, **Fences**, Decks, Patios or Storage Sheds



* Swimming Pools (above or in-ground)

* Windows (if opening size is modified or any window that protrudes from the face of the wall)

If you are unsure if you need a permit, call the Village Office.
