Ohio VINE & VINEMobile

VINE, is an information and notification resource that provides users the ability to search for information about an offender's custody status, and anonymously register for notifications when a change in status occurs. Vine is America's number one victim notification network.

VINE has been providing victims and concerned citizens with the power of information for decades, allowing these individuals to have the sense of security that they deserve.

VINELink can be accessed 24 hours a day, seven days a week, to provide the most reliable information for custody status changes and criminal case information.

VINEMobile is the mobile app version of VINE (Victim Information and Notification Everyday). This app allows crime victims to register for timely and reliable information about criminal cases and the custody status of offenders 24 hours a day. Victims and other concerned citizens can register to be notified by phone, email, text message (SMS) or TTY device when an offender's custody status changes.
