## Seasonal Roadway Concerns

The Village does not currently have equipment to vacuum and remove leaves. It is the resident's option to bag or compost leaves from their property. Please be aware that blowing yard debris into the roadway violates several laws and clogs the storm water system, leading to localized flooding on roadways. Please do not blow debris onto the roadway.

As winter approaches, also remember that the Village does not "remove" snow, but rather moves snow from the travel lanes of streets. Our primary responsibility is to ensure that emergency vehicles can get to each area.

Driveways will get snow piled up, inevitably right after the residents have shoveled them out. Please consider that in a night of plowing, the plow truck will pass about 450 driveways, in heavy snowfall two or three times. We can only move snow sideways off of streets.

## Monthly Water Meter Readings

Our water meters are read once a month, and most are read by a handheld reader electronically. However, it is not unusual for a maintenance worker from the Village Office to come to your home for a visual reading, if needed.

If someone comes to your home and you are unsure if it is a Village worker, do not hesitate to call our office to confirm before letting someone into your home. Your safety is important to us.

The Village of Lithopolis issues a 'utility bill', not solely a 'water bill'. However, many residents call their utility bill their water bill. Our utility bill includes all or some of the following charges:

*Water, Sewer, Stormwater, Trash and WAC (water availability charge)*

Below are the different ways you can make payments toward your utility account.

2 - Drop a Check or Money Order off at the office:  
Deliver inside in person OR drop into our silver drop-box located in circle driveway.

3 – Credit or Debit Card:  
Pay on our Village website at [www.lithopolis.org](http://www.lithopolis.org) OR pay inside our office.  
You must have your account number ready to use this option if done online.  
*Note: This option does charge a 3% fee to use.*

REMINDER: Please note your account number and/or location ID number on your check or moneyorder, and submit it with the top portion of your bill, to ensure payments are applied as they are meant to be.

RING THE BELL: If for some reason our front doors are locked during regular business hours, and there is not a note on the door as why, or when we will return, please ring our door bell and wait. We may just be upstairs.
