2019 PAVING PROJECT

The Village has completed the engineering, advertising, and bidding process for the 2019 Paving Project. Lithopolis Village Council authorized the contract award in the amount of \$245,859.00 to Columbus Asphalt Company at the August 14th meeting.

The project includes grinding/removing the top 1.5" of pavement and overlaying a new layer of asphalt. In addition, areas that have soft base material will be excavated and aggregate base established before paving.

The project will improve:


1. South Street from Elder through the intersection of Market Street
2. Market Street from South to Cherry Alley
(in front of the fire station)
3. Cherry Alley from Market to Walnut Street
(behind Eldrige and Fiske, Pump House, SunnySide)
4. Cherry Alley from Elder to Bootsies
5. Walnut Alley from Market to Strawberry Alley
(Police Station to El Pedrigal)

To complete the project as quickly as possible, South Street will be closed to through-traffic for paving. This will allow work to proceed on both lanes simultaneously and hopefully be completed in two days. Those residents who have no alternative access to their property will be allowed passage.

Access to the businesses from Cherry Alley will be maintained as much as possible, and the Village will co-ordinate with Bloom Carroll Schools and Bloom Fire Department to accommodate necessary traffic.

The Project will also replace portions of the northbound lane of Washington Street between Lithopolis Rd and Orwell Street and repair a section of Madolin Drive.

The Contractor has estimated a start date of September 10-20, 2019.
