POLICE BLOTTER-November 2016

On November 1, police responded to a two vehicle accident. A vehicle waiting at a traffic light was struck from behind by a vehicle which failed to stop. That operator was cited. Damage was minimal.

On November 12, police went to a local residence to arrest a male on a warrant for a probation violation. He barricaded himself in the bedroom and was found hiding in the attic.

On November 18, police stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation. A K-9 that responded to the scene alerted to the vehicle. The operator was arrested for possession of crystal meth.

On November 21, a resident reported his personal information was stolen and used to make fraudulent charges.

On November 22, police responded to a hit skip accident in which a mailbox was struck. The driver was located and cited.

On November 24, an officer observed a female walking who he believed to have an arrest warrant. After confirming her identity she was arrested on the warrant.

Charges were also filed for drug possession when she was discovered carrying crystal meth.

On November 27, police responded to a domestic violence incident. The male resident discovered that his wife had kissed another man and became violent. The male assaulted his wife and caused damage to the residence. He was charged with Domestic Violence.
