ORDINANCE NO. 34-17

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND APPROVING THE AMENDED 2017 APPROPRIATIONS BUDGET FOR THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 28-17.

WHEREAS, the Village is required to make Appropriations for Fiscal Year 2017, and

WHEREAS, the Village may adjust line items up or down during the fiscal year in order to meet its financial obligations, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. Council hereby repeals Ordinance 28-17.

Section 2. Council adopts and approves the Appropriation changes for Fiscal Year 2017, increases coming from unappropriated funds within each fund, specifically;

Table with 3 columns: Change Type, Description, Amount. Includes rows for Decrease (Transfers), Increase (Mayor - Personal, Utilities, Supplies and Materials, Contractual Services), and Increase (Pumping, Capital Outlay, Contractual Services).

Section 3. Council directs the Fiscal Officer to forward the Fund Balances and Appropriations to the Fairfield County Auditor.

Section 4. This Ordinance, being an Appropriation for the expenses of the Municipal Corporation, shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and signing by the Mayor.
