

RECORD OF ORDINANCE

Ordinance No. 12-18

Date Passed 4-17 20 18

An Ordinance providing for the purchase of one new Police Cruiser, and declaring an emergency:

Whereas, the Village is responsible for providing police patrol services to the residences of Lithopolis, and

Whereas, one of the current police cruisers is requiring more frequent repairs and is past it's usable life, and

Whereas, the loss of this police vehicle would negatively impact the ability of the police department to patrol the Village: and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. The Council of the Village of Lithopolis has determined that it is necessary to purchase one replacement police cruiser via state contract with financing through Ford Credit.

Section 2. The Village Administrator is hereby directed to execute the written contract to secure the vehicle that meets the specifications and needs of the Police Department.

Section 3. The cost and terms for the purchase are listed in Attachment A and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 4. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to turn over the current 2010 Dodge to the Utility Department of the Village

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety in this village and that having a safe and dependable vehicle is essential to the safe and efficient policing of the municipality.
