Ordinance No. 20-18

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE RENTS FOR WATER AND SEWER USE from 2019-2024.

Whereas, Council has authority to set reasonable rents for water and sewer use, and

Whereas, Council has responsibility to set rents at a level necessary to provide safe and secure utility service to the residents of the Lithopolis, and

Whereas, after careful consideration and review Council has determined the minimum rent increases necessary to continue safe and secure operations of the Water and Sewer Utilities, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

SECTION 1. Council modifies the water rents set in Article 3 (A) of Ordinance 23-07 and sets the following in-village rents effective on the date indicated below, per thousand gallons of usage.

Water	\$ 7.29	\$ 7.73	\$ 8.19	\$ 8.69	\$ 9.21

SECTION 2. Council modifies the sewer rents set in Article 3 (C) of Ordinance 23-07 and sets the following in-village rents effective on the date indicated below, per thousand gallons of usage.

Sewer	\$ 7.82	\$ 8.29	\$ 8.79	\$ 9.32	\$ 9.88

SECTION 3. Out of town rents for both utilities will be determined based on the in-village rents in this ordinance and using the multiplier included in Article 3(A) and (C) in Ordinance 23-07.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective and be in force at the earliest date provided by law.
