

RECORD OF ORDINANCE

Ordinance No. 21-18

Date Passed July 24th 20 18

An Ordinance vacating Brown Street south of East South Street running generally north and south between lots 112 and 113;

Whereas, this Council finds that a petition signed by the owners of all the property abutting upon said street has been presented to this Council praying that said street be vacated, and

Whereas, Council further finds that there is good cause for such vacation of said street as prayed for, that such vacation of the street will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made., and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. That Brown Street south of East South Street running generally north and south between lots 112 and 113 be hereby vacated on the condition that the owners of the property abutting thereupon shall convey to the Village of Lithopolis, easements for the construction, maintenance and operation of various public utilities owned by the municipality.

Section 2. The Village Administrator is hereby instructed to prepare a vacation plat of said street and the Fiscal Officer is instructed to endorse upon such plat, the action of this Council in vacating such street and to cause said plat to be recorded in the office of the Recorder of Fairfield County, Ohio.

Section 3. The Fiscal Officer is directed to notify the Auditor of Fairfield County of the vacation, by sending him a copy of this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall go into effect at the earliest date provided by law.
