

ORDINANCE 03-13

AN ORDINANCE AWARDING THE BID FOR SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING COLLECTION FOR THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, Council desires to provide standardized, regulated and mandatory solid waste and recycling collection in the village, and

Whereas, the Village has solicited bids for these services in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code, and

Whereas, Council has reviewed the received bids, and

Whereas, Council desires to waive all minor informalities and irregularities with the received bids and move forward with negotiating a contract with the lowest, best bidder,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

SECTION 1. Council hereby awards the Solid Waste and Recycling bid to Rumpke.

SECTION 2. Council authorizes the Mayor to negotiate a contract with the awarded bidder and bring such contract before Council, no later than February 26, 2013 for adoption.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in that the public peace, safety, health and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Lithopolis are involved and specifically to ensure prompt and adequate solid waste collection, thereby preserving the sanitary well being of the village. This Ordinance shall become effective and be in force immediately upon its passage by Council and signing by the Mayor.
