An Ordinance modifying the position of Village Administrator in accordance with the provisions of the Ohio Revised Code and repealing Ordinances 21-08;

Whereas, the Village has had a Village Administrator position for over the last decade, and

Whereas, there have been changes made to the Ohio Revised Code that modifies the position, and

Whereas, it is the judgment of this Council that the interests of the citizens of the village will be better served through the continuation of the position of Village Administrator as the current law allows;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. In accordance with section 735.271, Revised Code, there is hereby created the position of Village Administrator. The Village Administrator shall receive pay and benefits in accordance with the Village Standard Pay and Benefits Ordinance, which may be amended from time to time.


Section 2. The Village Administrator shall have those powers, duties, and functions as provided by the general laws of the State of Ohio including, but not exclusively, those listed below;

- A. The Village Administrator shall manage, conduct and control the water works and other public utilities, make bylaws and regulations necessary for the safe, economical, and efficient management and protection of plants and public utilities. These bylaws and regulations when not repugnant to municipal ordinances, resolutions or the Constitution of the State of Ohio, shall have the same validity of ordinances.
- B. The Village Administrator shall have the same powers and duties as are provided in Revised Code Section 735.273.
- C. The Village Administrator shall appoint those officers, employees, agents, clerks and assistants authorized by the village council. All hires must be filed with the Fiscal Officer and approved by the Mayor.
- D. In addition, the Village Administrator shall be the central purchasing agent for all offices, departments, divisions, boards, and commissions of the Village, and shall make contracts, purchase supplies or materials, and provide labor for any work of the village in the manner provided by Revised Code Section 731.141.


Section 3. The Village Administrator does not need to be a resident of the Village.
