

ORDINANCE 06-11

**AN ORDINANCE EXERCISING THE VILLAGE'S RIGHT UNDER SECTION 1.4 OF THE CONTRACT FOR SERVICES WITH TRACE'S A1 SANITATION, ADOPTED UNDER ORDINANCE 05-08 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**Whereas**, Council desires to continue to provide standardized, regulated and mandatory solid waste and recycling collection in the village, and

**Whereas**, the Solid Waste Collection Contract awarded to Trace's A1 Sanitation (here after "Contractor") allows for the Village to extend the original contract in two single year increments, and

**Whereas**, the contract allows for a fuel surcharge at the extension date, and

**Whereas**, Council desires to continue with the current contract and memorandums of understanding as previously negotiated with the Contractor, and

**Whereas**, a fuel surcharge of eighty cents (\$.80) per service has been negotiated between the Village and the Contractor, and

**Whereas**, Contractor, is ready, willing, and able to continue to provide these services on a permanent basis at a favorable rate, and in compliance with the needs of the village,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;**


**SECTION 1.** Council authorizes the Mayor to extend the contract with the Contractor, as adopted under ordinance 05-08 for one year from March 2011 to March 2012 under all current terms and MoUs.

**SECTION 2.** The rates, terms and conditions with the Contractor, are set forth in Attachment A, attached hereto, are incorporated by reference. Attachment includes original ordinance 05-08 and 2 Memorandum of Understanding.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in that the public peace, safety, health and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Lithopolis are involved and specifically to ensure prompt and adequate solid waste collection, thereby preserving the sanitary well being of the village. This Ordinance shall become effective and be in force immediately upon its passage by Council and signing by the Mayor.



**MEMORANDUM of UNDERSTANDING  
BETWEEN  
The Village of Lithopolis AND Trace's Sanitation**

**SUBJECT: Contract Clarifications**

1. **Purpose.** To clarify certain and specific terms of the contract adopted by Ordinance 05-08.
2. **Reference.** Village of Lithopolis Ordinance 05-08.
3. **Problem.** There are several differences in interpretation between the Village of Lithopolis and Traces Sanitation with regards to the contract that both parties would like to agree to and reduce to writing as opposed to resorting to legal action.
4. **Scope.** This MoU shall not add additional burden or obligations upon the Village of Lithopolis or Trace's Sanitation except where indicated. Failure to perform or adhere to this MoU will not constitute a breach of the original contract, but will render this document void and enforcement of the original contract may be sought through a Court of competent jurisdiction.
5. **Term.** This MoU will expire at the end of the current contract period, including any extensions or options that may granted.
6. **Effective date.** This agreement will be effective immediately upon signing by both signators.

7. Items –

- A. Trace's shall only be expected to collect a finite amount of solid waste from each residence or business. Residential locations shall be limited to the provided Trace's tote and two (2) loose bags or one (1) additional container not to exceed forty (40) gallons. Commercial locations shall not exceed their provided Trace's container (tote or dumpster).
- B. Trace's shall collect "large items" when notified in advance. Large items eligible for collection are: mattresses, box springs, couches, chairs, recliner chairs, stoves, washing machines, dryers, televisions, refrigerators & air conditioning units (refrigerant must be removed from unit to be eligible for collection). Trace's must be notified no later than the Tuesday prior to collection of a "large item" or Trace's will not collect the item. The charge for each large item will be \$8.00.
- C. Excessive trash shall be defined as trash left in excess of amount in (A) above.
- D. Excessive trash charge. Excessive trash will be charged @ \$2.00 per bag or 40 gallon container. Excessive trash will be collected and charged to the Village of Lithopolis. Trace's shall provide the date, address and amount on Trace's monthly billing statement to the Village to enable the Village to charge the property owner.
- E. Trace's shall notify the Village in the event of an excessive trash pickup so the Village may properly document the excessive trash or Trace's shall document the excessive trash and then collect the trash.
- F. The Village Administrator may require residential customers to receive and be charged for totes necessary to contain excessive trash if, in the Village Administrator's opinion, the residence consistently has excessive trash.
- G. Trace's shall not begin collections before 6:00 AM for any resident on Lithopolis Billing.
- H. Additional and/or larger recycling containers shall be accommodated and collected as other recycling.
- I. Third party paper recycling dumpsters are permitted for fund raising purposes.

**MEMORANDUM of UNDERSTANDING**  
**BETWEEN**

**Trace's A-1 Sanitation, Inc AND The Village of Lithopolis**

**SUBJECT: State Mandated Tipping Fee Increase**

1. **Purpose.** To establish terms for billing and payment of state mandated tipping fee increase.
2. **Reference.** Waste hauling contract between Trace's A-1 Sanitation & Village of Lithopolis
3. **Problem.** How to deal with the increased cost of waste disposal as a result of fee increase.
4. **Scope.** This MoU is to cover the issue of the state mandated tipping fee increase only and shall not place any additional burden or obligations upon Trace's A-1 Sanitation or the Village of Lithopolis except where indicated. Failure to perform or adhere to this MoU will not constitute a breach of the original contract, but will render this document void.
5. **Term.** This MoU will expire at the end of the current contract term and includes any extensions or options that may be granted.
6. **Effective date.** This MoU will be effective upon the signing by both signators and the rate will be retroactive to the date that the price increase took effect -- August 1, 2009.

7. Items –

- A. Trace's A-1 Sanitation, Inc will, as part of their monthly billing to the Village of Lithopolis for contracted services, include the monthly tonnage totals for the waste hauling. The tonnage total will be multiplied by \$1.25 per ton – the state mandated price increase for waste disposal-and the total cost will appear as a separate item on the monthly bill sent to the Village of Lithopolis.
  
- B. The Village of Lithopolis will pay the total cost for the monthly tonnage total as part of the regular monthly billing.

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING SOLID WASTE COLLECTION IN THE VILLAGE, AWARDED A CONTRACT TO TRACE'S SANITATION, LLC., REPEALING ORDINANCES 14-06 and 09-07-B, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**Whereas**, Council desires to provide standardized, regulated and mandatory solid waste and recycling collection in the village, and

**Whereas**, the Solid Waste Collection Contract awarded to Tack Hauling is unable to be fulfilled due to Tack Hauling's inability to meet the terms of the contract, and

**Whereas**, the village, its residents, businesses, and municipal service providers need immediate solid waste collection, and

**Whereas**, Council desires to award a franchise contract to facilitate solid waste pickup within the village, and

**Whereas**, Trace's Sanitation, LLC., has provided temporary collection under the current unexpired contract with Tack Hauling, and

**Whereas**, Trace's Sanitation, LLC., is ready, willing, and able to provide these services on a permanent basis upon short notice, at a favorable rate, and in compliance with the needs of the village,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;**

**SECTION 1.** Council authorizes the Mayor to execute a contract with Trace's Sanitation, LLC., to provide mandatory solid waste and recycling collection within the current municipal limits of the Lithopolis, which may change from time to time, and to provide optional solid waste service and recycling collection to users of other village utilities that may not currently be within the municipal limits. Trace's Sanitation, LLC., shall be the only agent approved to collect solid waste and recycling within the village.

**SECTION 2.** The rates, terms and conditions with Trace's Sanitation, LLC., are set forth in Attachment A, attached hereto, are incorporated by reference.

**SECTION 3.** Council directs the Village Administrator to oversee, manage and coordinate with Trace's Sanitation, LLC. the collection of solid waste and recycling.

**SECTION 3.** Council authorizes the collection of a solid waste franchise fee in the amount of one dollar (\$1.00) per month per service to be used for village beautification, cleanliness, refuse abatements and other items as deemed necessary and appropriate by the Mayor and Council.

**SECTION 4.** Each residential or business parcel with a structure shall receive an appropriate solid waste container(s) and recycling bin(s) and shall be billed accordingly for the collection service.

**SECTION 5.** For multi-family units each equivalent dwelling unit (EDU) shall have a separate tote, or if required by the Village Administrator, a commercial dumpster with sufficient capacity to contain the solid waste generated by all of the multi-family units located on a single parcel.

**SECTION 7.** The property owner, or agent for the property owner in the case of a multi-family unit operated by a separate landlord or management agency, shall be the billed party for trash services.

**SECTION 8.** Recyclable materials placed at the curb or in recycling bins are the property of the Village and/or its authorized agent. It is a violation of this ordinance for any person unauthorized by the Village to collect or pick up or cause to be collected or picked up any such recyclables. Any and each such collection in violation hereof shall constitute a separate and distinct offense punishable as hereinafter provided in Section 11.

**SECTION 9.** Rates for services shall be set as follows including the franchise fee.

All residential prices include 1 Toter and curb-side recycling bin.

**SECTION 11.** Any person, firm or corporation who violates or neglects to comply with any Section of this ordinance, or any regulations promulgated pursuant thereto, shall upon conviction thereof, be punishable by a fine not to exceed one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars. Each and every day that said violation continues shall be considered a separate offense.

**SECTION 12.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in that the public peace, safety, health and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Lithopolis are involved and specifically to ensure prompt and adequate solid waste collection, thereby preserving the sanitary well being of the village. This Ordinance shall become effective and be in force immediately upon its passage by Council and signing by the Mayor.

## CONTRACT FOR WASTE HAULING SERVICES

This agreement made and executed this, 12th day of February 2008, between the Village of Lithopolis, Ohio and Trace's A-1 Sanitation, Inc. (Trace's):

### RECITALS

1.1 Whereas it has been ~~is has been~~ determined by the Lithopolis Village Council that Trace's proposal for solid waste hauling and disposal service is in the best interests of the residents of the Village of Lithopolis; and

1.2 Whereas Lithopolis has need for solid waste hauling and disposal services as of January 1, 2008, by reason of cessation of solid waste hauling and disposal services by its current provider; and

1.3 Whereas Lithopolis and Trace's have negotiated mutually agreeable terms for a contract to provide solid waste hauling and disposal service to Lithopolis residents;

Now, therefore, in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants and agreement contained herein, the parties agree AS FOLLOWS:

### AGREEMENT

1.4 This contract shall commence on March 1, 2008 and remain in effect for a period of three years, provided however, that Lithopolis may twice extend the term of this contract for an additional year, for a total of five years, at the sole discretion of Lithopolis and upon the original terms of this contract, subject to cost adjustment for additional fuel costs to be negotiated between Trace's and the Village Administrator.

1.5 During the term of this agreement, and extensions, Trace's agrees to collect and remove all solid waste, as defined by Ohio Administrative Code § 3745-27-01 (24), by curb service, from all buildings, structures, places of business, dwellings, stores, office buildings, schools, municipal buildings, garages, public markets and other places of accumulation, all in accordance with the contract as contained herein, and Trace's shall make a complete and thorough collection and disposal thereof.

1.6 "Recyclables" as defined by R.C. § 1502.01(G), are included within the scope of this contract.



1.7 Consideration to be Paid: For the full and faithful performance of the services to be performed by Trace's pursuant to this agreement, Trace's shall be compensated in accordance with the schedule of rates and charges attached hereto as Appendix A. Payments shall be paid to Trace's by Lithopolis by within 20 days of being invoiced, for services rendered in the prior month. The Customer Count shall be based upon the record of active customers maintained by Lithopolis. The count and billing owed to Trace's will be adjusted to reflect changes in active customers at the end of every quarter, beginning with January 1, 2008.

1.8 Mandatory Collection. Solid waste and recyclables collection by Trace's shall be exclusive and mandatory in all areas within Lithopolis and for all residents of Lithopolis for all services available through Trace's. Collection shall be curb side and no solid waste or recyclables shall be subject to collection if not located at the curb.

1.9 Collection Schedule. Collection shall be made every Wednesday. Pickup shall not begin before 6:00 a.m. and shall be completed by 6:00 p.m. The pickup day shall be changed only upon written agreement of the parties. Trace's shall use its best efforts to advise all persons from whom it is collecting garbage and refuse of the collection schedule, and shall further exert its best efforts to maintain actual collection in accordance with the schedule.

2.0 Areas to be Served. The area to be served shall be the entire area within the village limits of Lithopolis as it now exists or is expanded during the effective dates of this Agreement, or contracted by annexation or detachment during the term of this Agreement or as otherwise contracted and agreed upon in writing. Nothing herein shall be construed to indicate that any collection other than curb collection is the subject of this agreement.

Additionally, Trace's will be the recommended contractor for solid waste hauling and garbage collection in those areas outside the village limits of Lithopolis, Ohio in those areas currently being served by village utilities. It is understood that the Village has no authority to require those areas to utilize Trace's. Those areas shall be subject to the same rates as areas within the limits of Lithopolis.

2.1 Action by Trace's Employees. Trace's shall require all employees to be courteous at all times and not to use loud or profane language, and to do their work as quietly as possible. Employees, in collecting garbage and other solid waste, shall follow the regular pedestrian walkways while on private property, returning to the street or alley after replacing empty receptacle. They shall also replace all receptacle covers and close all gates opened by them. Employees shall not trespass or cross property to neighbors' premises. In the event of satisfactory behavior not being displayed after notice of continued complaints about the employee, Trace's management shall meet with the Village Administrator to reach a reasonable resolution of the problem. No reasonable resolution shall be refused by either side.

**2.2 Loading.** Trace's shall exercise care in the loading, compacting and transportation of garbage and other solid waste so that none of the materials collected or to be collected is left on private property, streets or alleys. Trace's shall have no obligation to collect garbage or solid waste that is not deposited on the curb on the appointed day for collection. No loose waste material shall be collected by Trace's.

Trace's shall be responsible for the cleaning of all garbage, solid waste, or debris spilled or tracked on any street, alley or public place by any of its employees or equipment. If Trace's fails to clean the same within 24 hours after notice is given by the Village Administrator, the Village Administrator may cause such streets to be cleaned and charge the reasonable cost for the same to Trace's.

**2.3 Special Collections.** Adequate provision shall be made by Trace's to provide special collections when garbage and other solid waste has not been collected during a regularly scheduled trip. Special pick ups for missed collection shall be made by Trace's when ordered by the Village Administrator. For the purposes of this paragraph, "missed collection" shall not include collections not made for reasons beyond the control of Trace's, such as "acts of God," access blocked by street construction or temporary road surface condition due to unusual and inclement weather, and similar circumstances.

It shall not be considered a missed collection if the customer has not placed his or her garbage or other solid waste out for collection by 6:00 a.m. on the collection day. A make up or special collection shall not be required in this case. If for good cause, the Village Administrator determines that a special collection is required in this case and orders Trace's to do so, Trace's shall make the collection and the customer shall be assessed its additional reasonable cost, not to exceed \$25.00, which shall be remitted to Trace's in addition to its normal fees.

Garbage or other solid waste left purposely by Trace's shall be tagged to indicate why it was not picked up or the Village Administrator shall be notified before the end of the collection day. Reasons for leaving and tagging items shall include the following: weight of item; hazardous materials or excluded special waste; and materials not properly contained. Other reasons may be established with mutual written agreement of the Village Administrator and Trace's.

When Trace's reasonably determines that an inclement weather condition prevents Trace's from providing safe service on its regular schedule, Trace's shall notify the Village Administrator as soon as possible, and, if the delay is two days or less, Trace's shall use its best efforts to pick up garbage as soon as possible after the inclement weather condition has subsided. Should inclement weather delay regular garbage pickup for three days or more, Trace's may omit that week's collection and resume collection on the next schedule pickup day. Trace's shall pick up all additional garbage from Lithopolis residents due to this delay at no additional charge.

2.4 **Collection Equipment.** In collecting garbage and other solid waste, Trace's shall use a completely enclosed truck and/or container unit that is designed for the collection of garbage and other solid waste, and that is capable of servicing residential and commercial accounts. Trace's shall maintain all equipment in good working order to minimize the interruption and delay in pick-up schedules resulting from equipment breakdown.

2.5 **Method of Disposal.** Trace's shall deliver, at its cost, all garbage and other solid waste to a disposal site that is approved for such use by all local, state, and federal authorities. As between Trace's and Lithopolis, Trace's shall be responsible to see that all garbage and other solid waste complies with all local, state and federal regulations with regard to content, hauling and disposal.

2.6 **Recycling.** Recycling services will be provided as state in Appendix B for all newspapers, mixed paper, aluminum, glass and other materials for which recycling is commercially reasonable and available.

2.7 **Ownership of Equipment.** All equipment used in the performance of this contract shall be owned, leased or rented by Trace's.

2.8 **Offices.** Trace's shall maintain an office provided with a telephone and such attendant as may be necessary to take care of complaints, orders for special service, or instructions from the Village Administrator during normal business hours. At all times, the telephone shall be equipped to answer calls.

2.9 **Special Arrangements.** Trace's agrees to remove and dispose of all garbage and other solid waste from all municipally owned or operated locations free of charge. Trace's shall also furnish, place, and timely remove when so requested by Lithopolis, temporary containers for two special events per year at no additional charge. The events will be determined by Lithopolis and Lithopolis will determine the correct number and size of containers to be placed at said events.

3.0 **Operating Permit.** Trace's shall obtain and pay for all permits or licenses required by Lithopolis or any other governmental unit which shall be required under this contract, including but not limited to Workers' Compensation. Lithopolis shall not increase the cost of any municipal permit to Trace's during the term of this contract unless such increase is a general increase in permit fee or cost required of all persons obtaining such permit or license.

3.1 **Indemnification.** Trace's further agrees to indemnify and hold Lithopolis harmless for any and all claims, demands, rights, charges, actions, interest, debts, liabilities, damages, costs, expenses and any other cause of action, of whatever type or nature, either legal or equitable, whether known or unknown, which may accrue against Lithopolis from any action or omission, solely committed or omitted, by Trace's, its agents, sub-contractors, or employees, performed pursuant to this contract.

3.2 **Liability Insurance.** Trace's shall provide and maintain in full force and effect during the entire term of this contract, or any renewal thereof, an automobile insurance policy that complies with state minimums for all automobiles used for garbage and other solid waste hauling.

3.2.1 **Performance Bond.** Trace's shall provide a waste hauler's bond as a condition of this contract.

3.3 **Service Provider to Make Examinations.** Trace's shall conduct its own examination, investigation, and research regarding the proper method of doing the work, and all equipment and materials needed thereon, and the quality of the work to be performed. Trace's agrees that its conclusion to enter into the proposed contract is based upon such investigation and research, and that it shall make no claim against Lithopolis because of any of the estimates, statements, or interpretations made by any officer or agent of Lithopolis which may prove to be erroneous.

Trace's assume the risk of all conditions, foreseen and unforeseen, and agrees to continue work without additional compensation under whatever circumstances may develop other than as provided herein.

3.4 **Holidays.** Trace's, within thirty days of executing this Agreement, shall designate which holidays it will observe, and shall then indicate the schedule it will make collections if the holiday falls on a regular collection day.

3.5 **Workmen.** All workmen employed by Trace's shall be competent in the performance of the work to which they are assigned. Failure or delay in the performance of this contract caused by Trace's inability to obtain workmen of the number and competence required shall constitute a default of this contract.

3.6 **Company Name.** Trace's shall not use a company or firm name containing the words "Lithopolis," "Village," or any other name implying municipal ownership by the Village of Lithopolis.

3.7 **Non-discrimination in Employment.** Trace's shall at all times during the term of this contract engage in employment practices in a manner whereby equal opportunity is observed and practiced without regard to race, color, religion, age, sex or national origin.

3.8 **Construction of Site Containers.** No containers, including containers placed temporarily at construction sites within the Village shall be located so as to hinder the safe and free travel of pedestrians, motor vehicles, or other users of public rights-of-way, or be placed within any public right-of-way unless permission is first obtained from Lithopolis. Verbal permission from the Village Administrator shall be sufficient permission. Trace's shall be the exclusive provider throughout Lithopolis for all construction containers for solid waste disposal and construction material disposal.

3.9 Qualified Senior Citizen Rate. Trace's compensation for collection of garbage and other solid waste from single family residences occupied solely by qualified senior citizens shall be set forth in Appendix A. "Qualified senior citizens" means persons who meet the following criteria:

- Must be the primary resident or homeowner
- Applicant and/or spouse, if married, must be 62 years of age or older

4.0 Customers and New Accounts. The Administrative Assistant shall be the point of contact in the Village and shall supply Trace's with pick-up addresses and any qualifying rates (senior rates). At least quarterly, or more often as new residents move into the Village, the Administrative Assistant shall provide an updated name and address listing to Trace's for pick-up purposes. Each residential and commercial lot with a structure, whether occupied or not, shall be required to have solid waste pick-up service.


4.1 Termination by Trace's. Nothing in this contract shall be construed so as to prevent Trace's from terminating this agreement for breach of the same by Lithopolis.

4.2 Tipping Fee Increase & Solid Waste District Charge. Both parties understand that the solid waste district of Fairfield County, Ohio has authority to increase its tipping fees and that Trace's is required to pay the tipping fee or solid waste district fee even if solid waste is not deposited in one of its land fill operations. In the event that said tipping fees or solid waste district charges are increased, Lithopolis shall increase the fees paid to Trace's by the same amount as the additional fee imposed.


