An Ordinance providing for the purchase of one new Police Cruiser, repealing Ordinance 14-14 and declaring an emergency;

Whereas, the Village is responsible for providing police patrol service to the residents of Lithopolis, and

Whereas, one of the current police cruisers is requiring more frequent repairs and is past its' usable life, and

Whereas, the loss of this police vehicle would negatively impact the ability of the Police Department to patrol the Village; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. Ordinance 14-14 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. The Council of the Village of Lithopolis has determined that it is necessary to purchase one replacement police cruisers via the state contract with financing through Key Government Finance.

Section 3. The Village Administrator is hereby directed to execute the written contract to secure the vehicle that meets the specifications and needs of the Police Department.

Section 4. The cost and terms for the purchase are listed in Attachment A and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 5. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to dispose of the current Crown Victoria to any other law enforcement agency, priced at his discretion.

Section 6. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety in this Village, in that having an all-weather Police vehicle is essential to the safe and efficient policing of the municipality.
