

Ordinance 08-11

An Ordinance creating UAN budgetary line items in revenue and expenditures in order to track OPWC payments for the Columbus Street Project and declaring an emergency;

Whereas, the Village is required to create revenue and expenditure line items for the OPWC Columbus Street Project, and

Whereas, the Village is required to budget and appropriate in these line items, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. Council approves the creation of Revenue line item 4901-310-0000 and Expenditure line item 4901-800-500-0000.

Section 2. Council approves expected Revenue in the amount of \$ 805,045.21 for line item 4901-310-0000.

Section 3. Council approves Expenditures in the amount of \$ 805,045.21 for line item 4901-800-500-0000.

Section 4. Council understands that the Village will not receive any actual funding and these line items are strictly pass-through items and OPWC will pay the Contractor(s) directly.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare in that the Village must have proper Appropriations to lawfully spend money. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
