

Ordinance 10-10

An Ordinance adopting and approving a revised 2010 Appropriations Budget for the Village of Lithopolis, repealing Ordinance 03-10 and declaring an emergency;

Whereas, the Village is required to make Appropriations for Fiscal Year 2010, and

Whereas, the Village has previously adopted Ordinance 03-10 Revised Appropriations for 2010, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;


Section 1. Council repeals Ordinance 03-10.

Section 2. Council adopts and approves the revised Appropriations for Fiscal Year 2010 Attachment A and incorporated herein.


Section 3. The specific modifications are listed in Attachment A.
