

ORD. 17-11

An Ordinance adopting and approving the 2012 Tax Budget for the Village of Lithopolis and declaring an emergency;

Whereas, the Village is required to adopt a Tax Budget on or before July 15th, 2011, and


Whereas, the Village is required to submit the adopted Tax Budget to the County on or before July 20th, 2011, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. The Council of the Village of Lithopolis adopts and approves the Tax Budget for 2012 attached and incorporated herein.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare in that the Tax Budget must be adopted on or before July 15th. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
