

ORDINANCE 22-15

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF THE STRAWSER PAVING COMPANY, 1595 FRANK ROAD COLUMBUS OHIO 43223, FOR THE 2015 VILLAGE WIDE RESURFACING PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, Council has heretofore authorized the Mayor to solicit bids for the Village Wide Resurfacing Project (hereinafter "the Project") and

**WHEREAS**, the Fiscal Officer and the Village's Consulting Engineer did cause legal notice to be published soliciting such sealed bids according to law; and

**WHEREAS**, the bid of the Strawser Paving Company to furnish such services has been favorably recommended by the Administration and the Village Consulting Engineer; and

**WHEREAS**, Council desires to waive all informalities, irregularities and inconsistencies and award said project to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder; and

**WHEREAS**, Council has decide to non-perform part of the contract;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Village of Lithopolis, County of Fairfield and State of Ohio:

**SECTION I:** The bid that the Strawser Paving Company submitted pursuant to the Village's plans and specifications for the furnishing of the Project is hereby determined to be the lowest, responsive and responsible bid.

**SECTION II:** That Council hereby awards the contract, less Segments F and Segment I of the Project, to the Strawser Paving Company, waiving all informalities, irregularities and inconsistencies.


**SECTION III:** That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to make and enter into a contract on behalf of the Village with the Strawser Paving Company for completion of the project less segments non-performed.


**SECTION IV:** That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to make payments to Strawser Paving Company for work performed under the contract.

**SECTION V:** That any and all other bids so received by the Village of Lithopolis for the Project are hereby rejected and the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to return to such other bidders the certified checks, cash or bid bonds received accompanying such other bids upon execution of the indentures above referred to.

**SECTION VI:** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lithopolis, and for the additional reasons due to the scope and nature of the Project an immediate start date is preferred to reduce the amount of time that village streets are closed or restricted to traffic. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and signature of the Mayor.
