

Ordinance 27-15

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF ROCK RIVER CONSTRUCTION LTD. (HEREINAFTER "CONTRACTOR") FOR THE 2015 COLUMBUS STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT – PHASE II/III, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, Council has heretofore authorized the Mayor to solicit bids for the Columbus Street Reconstruction Project – Phase II/III (hereinafter "the Project") and

**WHEREAS**, the Fiscal Officer and the Village's Consulting Engineer did cause legal notice to be published in the Lancaster Eagle Gazette soliciting such sealed bids according to law; and

**WHEREAS**, the bid of Rock River Construction Ltd., Inc. to furnish such services has been favorably recommended by the Village Staff; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project is funded by the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) and is known to them as Project CQ25S/CQ26S; and

**WHEREAS**, Council desires to waive all informalities, irregularities and inconsistencies and award said project to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Village of Lithopolis, County of Fairfield and State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1** That the bid the contractor submitted pursuant to the Village's plans and specifications for the furnishing of the Project is hereby determined to be the lowest, responsive and responsible bid.

**SECTION 2** That Council hereby awards the contract for the Project to Rock River Construction Ltd., waiving all informalities, irregularities and inconsistencies.

**SECTION 3** That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute all agreements, contracts and paperwork necessary for the successful completion of the Project behalf of the Village.

**SECTION 4** That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to appropriate funding in UAN for disbursement of OPWC funding.

**SECTION 5** That any and all other bids so received by the Village of Lithopolis for the Project are hereby rejected and the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to return to such other bidders the certified checks, cash or bid bonds received accompanying such other bids upon execution of the indentures above referred to.

**SECTION 6** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Lithopolis, and for the additional reasons due to the scope and nature of the Project an immediate start date is preferred to reduce the amount of time that Columbus Street is closed to traffic. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and signature of the Mayor.
