An Ordinance reducing the Water Availability Charge for the Village of Lithopolis and declaring an emergency;

Whereas, in 2008 Council set the rate of the Water Availability Charge (WAC) to \$25 per month, and

Whereas, in 2015 Council set the rate of the Water Availability Charge (WAC) to \$15 per month, and

Whereas, Ordinance 19-08 Section 8 authorizes Council to suspend or reduce the amount of the WAC, and

Whereas, The 2020 budget provides sufficient revenue in the Water Enterprise fund to reduce the WAC charge to \$12.50, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. Village Council reduces the WAC charge from \$15.00 to \$12.50.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare in that it is in the best interest of Village resident to pass this saving along to them as quickly as possible and shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
