ESTABLISHING NO PARKING ZONES AND GUIDELINES WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 08-17;

WHEREAS, the Lithopolis Village Subdivision Regulations, in conformity with the Fairfield County Subdivision Regulations, established the width of certain roadways within the municipal limits, and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Lithopolis has adopted, by ordinance, the Ohio Basic Code; and,

WHEREAS, Ohio Basic Code 76.04 and 76.10 establishes the parameters for parking violations, and,

WHEREAS, Council desires, by ordinance to clarify and make clear where and when specific no parking violations shall be enforced, and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. That Council hereby finds that it is in the best interest of the safety and welfare of the Village to clarify these guidelines as follows.

Section 2. There shall be no on-street parking on any street less than 17' from face of curb to face curb or the edge of pavement, if no curb, when the travel lanes are marked or unmarked regardless if the area is marked as no-parking.

Section 3. Parking may be permitted on one side of the street where the road width, face of curb to face of curb is 25' or more when the travel lanes are unmarked.

Section 4. No parking within 50' from of a narrowing or reduction in road width.

Section 5. Parking may be permitted on both sides of the street where the road width, face of curb to face of curb is at least 33' on a marked/unmarked roadway unless the Fire Department, Local School District or Village Administrator has determined parking on both sides of the street could impede public service and have provided written notice to the village. In which case one side of the street shall be marked as no-parking.

Section 6. Where parking is restricted to one side of the street, no parking shall be on the side where the fire hydrants are located. Where no hydrants are located between cross-streets, the Village Administrator shall determine the no-parking side of the street.

Section 7. Nothing in this ordinance shall prevent the village from establishing Emergency Snow Routes that prohibit on-street parking, establishing no-parking zones petitioned for by residents, or exercising any other authority pertaining to streets and road within the corporation limits.

Section 8. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force at the earliest time permitted by
