AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THAT ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS PRESENTED TO COUNCIL BE PRESENTED TO COUNCIL WITH A STAMPED OR TYPED DATE INDICATING THE YEAR-MONTH-DATE THE PROPOSAL IS FIRST PRESENTED, AND THE SPONSORING MEMBER'S NAME, AND A STAMP WITH A SPACE TO RECORDS THE 1st, 2nd, A REVISED 2nd, AND 3rd READING DATE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council finds that ordinances or resolutions concerning similar respective topics are sometimes presented to council for consideration within a short period of time; and

WHEREAS, the absence, in particular, of documents and resolutions sufficient identifying information on any proposal prior to discussion, especially on those instruments concerning similar topics, may lead to confusion during council discussion;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO.

Section 1. Any ordinance presented to council for discussion shall be presented to council with a stamped or typed date indicating the year-month-date the proposed ordinance is first presented, the sponsoring member's name, and a stamp with a space to record the 1st, 2nd, a revised 2nd, and a 3rd reading date.

Section 2. Any resolution presented to council for discussion shall be presented to council with a stamped or typed date indicating the year-month-date the proposal is first presented, and the sponsoring member's name, and a stamp with a space to records the 1st, 2nd, a revised 2nd, and a 3rd reading date.

Section 3. In practice, this information would provide the following:
