AWARDING ECONOMIC RELIEF FUNDING TO LOCAL BUSINESSES THAT HAVE SEEN ADDITIONAL EXPENSES AND REVENUE LOSS DUE TO INTERRUPTIONS CAUSED BY COVID-19 RELATED BUSINESS CLOSURES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY;

WHEREAS, the Village of Lithopolis has received additional funding from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, 116 Public Law 136, (the CARES Act) via the Ohio General Assembly's "Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act" in H.B. 481 of the 133rd General Assembly (H.B. 481); and

WHEREAS, the Village of Lithopolis has requested redistribution of unspent funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to assist local businesses that have suffered economic losses due to the COVID-19 outbreak, by disbursing the funding to approved applicants, and

WHEREAS, Council passed Ordinance 17-20 setting a process for awarding funding, and

WHEREAS, the Village has previously solicited applications from local businesses and carried over previous applicants that were not fully funding to earlier rounds, and

WHEREAS, Council tasked the Finance Committee to review the applications and recommend the level of funding for each applicant, and

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee has completed that task and sent a list of grantees and funding amount to Council for action, and

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee has based its recommendation on the disbursement estimates sent out by Fairfield and Franklin counties, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. The Finance Committee recommends the final round distribution of CARE Act funding be allocated as follows:

Long's Towing	\$1,000.00
Old Blue Roster	\$1,000.00
Bootsies	\$1,000.00
Sunnyside Childcare	\$1,000.00
Village of Lithopolis	\$3,167.58 +/-
TOTAL	\$7,167.58 +/-

Section 2. Council hereby accepts the Finance Committee's recommendations to make the distributions from the Lithopolis COVID-19 Economic Relief Program.

Section 3. Council directs the Mayor to prepare Grant Agreements for each awardee.

Section 4. Council directs the Fiscal Officer to contact the awardees, ensure the Grant Agreement is complete and issue payments for the amount listed herein.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare in that small business' need local economic support and there are State mandated deadlines that must be followed. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and signing by the Mayor.
