

Whereas the Village has been approached by the Lithopolis Garden Club concerning placing flower pots within the public right of way between Market Street and Walnut St; and

Whereas Council is supportive of the idea with certain conditions; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

- Section 1** Lithopolis Village Council authorizes the placement of planters within the Village right-of-way between Market Street and Walnut Street with the following conditions.
- A. Purchase and upkeep of the planters will be by the Lithopolis Garden Club and/or local businesses.
 - B. The planters will be located such that there continues to be 48" of unencumbered sidewalk available to pedestrians.
 - C. No other items may be placed near or around the planters that would reduce the unencumbered sidewalk to less than 48".
 - D. The Village Administrator may remove any planter that becomes damaged, unsightly, overgrown, used as a receptacle for trash or cigarette butts or presents a health or safety concern.
 - E. If a planter is removed from the street, the Lithopolis Garden Club shall have ten (10) calendar days to pick up the planter. After the ten (10) days the Village shall dispose of the planter as it sees fit.

Section 2 This Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
