A Resolution indicating a need for increased revenue for various municipal projects;

Whereas, Village Council has determined that additional revenue is necessary to maintain and continue improvements in public safety and the public infrastructure, and

Whereas, Village Council has discussed in Regular Meetings, solicited the feedback from the citizens through public meetings and has published the available options in the Village Newsletter for the last three months, and

Whereas, Council has determined that an income tax increase, authorized by the electorate, would accomplish the goals of maintaining and improving public safety and the public infrastructure, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. Council hereby indicates the need for additional revenue through an income tax increase of .50% for a fixed term of five (5) years.

Section 2. The increase in the income tax shall be used for public safety and capital projects, specifically street construction, maintenance and repair, the general maintenance and repair of public buildings acquisition of public parkland and the addition of a fulltime police officer.

Section 3. The question shall be put on the ballot before the voters of the Village of Lithopolis on August 04, 2020 and the Fairfield County Board of Elections shall conduct such election.

Section 4. The new rate, if approved shall become effective January 01, 2021.

Section 5. Council directs the Fiscal Officer to forward this resolution of need and ballot language, attached and incorporated herein, to the Fairfield County Board of Elections.

Section 6. This resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
