A RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE SEWER SERVICES, WATER, POLICE, AND FRANCHISED SOLID WASTE PICKUP SERVICES TO THE TERRITORY TO BE ANNEXED AND OWNED BY DONALD R. LONG, DEBORAH L. LONG, ERIC A. LONG, KELLY G. LONG, TADD W. LONG, AND THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPLIS, ANNEXATION PETITIONERS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Lithopolis, Fairfield County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. The Village of Lithopolis shall provide sewer services, water, police, and franchised solid waste pickup services to the territory proposed for annexation upon annexation. The property to be annexed is the property of DONALD R. LONG, DEBORAH L. LONG, ERIC A. LONG, KELLY G. LONG, TADD W. LONG, and the VILLAGE OF LITHOPLIS, and is more fully described in the Annexation Map, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference, and the Metes and Bounds Description, attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated by reference.

SECTION 2. The territory must comply with all Village Ordinances and Subdivision Regulations to receive utility services.



This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in that the public peace, safety, health and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village is involved and specifically because the Village requires development of adequate, well-planned housing within the Village. This Ordinance shall become effective and be in force immediately upon its passage by Council and signing by the Mayor.
