

RESOLUTION 06 - 16

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO DISPOSE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE, AS IT IS OBSOLETE OR UNFIT FOR THE USE FOR WHICH IT WAS ACQUIRED, AND IT HAS NO VALUE, IN ACCORD WITH R.C. 721.15.**

**WHEREAS**, The Village of Lithopolis was once the organizer and operator of an annual street festival known as the Lithopolis Honeyfest; and

**WHEREAS**, during its years of operating the Honeyfest, the Village accumulated a variety of personal property, including cookbooks, t-shirts, prize ribbons, office supplies and other small items; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village no longer organizes or operates the Honeyfest, and

**WHEREAS**, Council has determined that these items are now obsolete or unfit for use by the Village, and have no value to the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, these same items may be useful to the current organizers and operators of the Lithopolis Honeyfest, a not-for-profit 501(c)(3) organization:

**WHEREAS**, R.C. 721.15 authorizes the Village to dispose of personal property that is obsolete or unfit for the use for which it was acquired;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;**

**SECTION 1.** In accord with R.C. 721.15, Council authorizes the Mayor to donate to the current Honeyfest organizers, at no cost, or to otherwise dispose of, any and all Honeyfest-themed personal property having no value to the village, including Honeyfest cookbooks, t-shirts, prize ribbons, office supplies, or other personal property acquired in past years by the village specifically for operating the Honeyfest.

This Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date provided by law.
