POLICE BLOTTER-September 2017

**On September 5,** a resident reported that a rock was thrown at the windshield of her car while it was parked in front of her home. There were no witnesses to the incident.

**On September 6,** a person stated he was giving a ride to an acquaintance when the person pulled a gun on him and forced him to take out a cash advance loan at a Columbus business. The incident is currently under investigation.

**On September 7,** a child riding a bicycle past a business was struck by a vehicle which was pulling out from the business. The child suffered minor injuries from the accident.

**On September 15,** a resident reported an unauthorized access to an online shopping site. The resident cancelled the account and the incident was forwarded to the Delaware State Police, where the unauthorized user resides.

**On September 21,** police investigated an accident in which a car was driven through the side of a building, damaging the structural integrity. The operator claimed the car spontaneously accelerated in the parking lot.

**On September 29,** a resident reported she was in her home when an intruder entered through the back door. The intruder was bitten by a large dog in the residence, but managed to escape without taking any property.
