**Public Comments:**

Zoom – Dominic Caminiti of Strawser Paving explains the micro surfacing project done in the village. A discussion takes place regarding the quality of work done in certain areas. Mr. Caminiti agrees to meet with the Mayor and drive around the village to address the concerns.

**Mayors Report:**

Mayor Sandine shares the opioid settlement amounts the village will receive from both Fairfield and Franklin Counties.

The Mayor shares with council an email regarding the watermain break in Bloom Canyon to clarify the actual time of response and the amount of water lost.

**Old Business:**

A 1<sup>st</sup> Reading of an Ordinance approving the Employee Policy Manual takes place.

**Officers Report:**

**Chief** – Chief Barton shares a few unusual traffic stops with council.

**Village Administrator** - nothing

**Fiscal Officer** – A Reading of Ordinance 14-22 Adopting and Approving a 2022 Supplemental Revenue Increase and Appropriations Budget takes place.

**Round Robin:**

**Belek-** asks about the wooden sign frame on the corner lot. Amanda assures him it will be taken down as soon as they can.

**Brown-** asks if council is interested in reducing the speed limit on Lithopolis Rd from the traffic light at St Rt 674 into town. Mayor shares they are looking into some safety issues that have come up since the new sidewalk has gone in. Shares with council an idea discussed at the committee meeting regarding having a contest to name Stoney Bluff greenspace area.

**Greene** – asks if parking in the Subdivisions can get back on the agenda. Belek asks to invite Chief Williams. Mayor agrees to invite the chief.

**Long** – are the apartments on Columbus St. required to provide parking for tenants? Mayor says not the pre-existing apartments. Any newly built apartments would be required to provide parking.

**Daniels-** voices concern about delivery drivers speeding through the subdivisions. Chief Barton says they have issued tickets in the past.

**Tennant-** is there an Ordinance regarding blocking the sidewalk when parked in a driveway? Chief Barton says yes, it is usually complaint driven.
