AN ORDINANCE GRANTING FUNDING TO CANAL WINCHESTER HUMAN SERVICES TO PROVIDE SENIOR AND OTHER SERVICES TO RESIDENTS OF LITHOPOLIS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council desires to make Senior services including transportation services available to the residents of Lithopolis; and

WHEREAS, Canal Winchester Human Services, a 501(C)(3) organization, has agreed to provide services to Lithopolis residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. Council will grant \$2,500 in Fiscal Year 2021 from unappropriated revenue to Canal Winchester Human Services to provide services, including senior transportation, emergency assistance, food bank, Tools for School and other community programs.

Section 2. Council directs the Village Administrator to be Lithopolis' liaison with Canal Winchester Human Services.

Section 3. Lithopolis and Canal Winchester Human Services will reevaluate the funding levels at the end of 2021 to ensure adequate funding is available to help support Lithopolis' residents use of the services.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is declared an emergency, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, specifically ~~that~~ Council desires to make these services available to residents at the earliest date provided by law.
