AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PREMIUM PAY CATEGORY FOR SEWER CALLS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council desires to provide additional incentives for hourly workers who respond to wastewater calls, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Village Administrator have suggested a premium payment per sewer call, and,

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee reviewed the proposal and recommended setting the premium pay amount to \$75 (seventy-five dollars) per call, and

WHEREAS, Council agrees to create a premium pay category with some conditions,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. Council hereby sets the sewer call premium payment at \$75 (seventy-five dollars) per call.

Section 2. The pay shall be earned and payable as regular pay only to Maintenance Repair Workers.

Section 3. The pay shall be subject to the following conditions.

1. Call must have an official workorder generated.
2. Payable to one employee per work order.
3. Pay is earned per workorder on completed job. A job that takes two days to resolve only earns one payment.
4. Multiple calls to the same address within 3 (three) days of the initial workorder does not earn multiple payments.
5. Multiple visits due to awaiting parts or an outside vendor does not earn multiple payments.
6. Any questions over a valid payment shall be decided by the Village Administrator.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in that the public peace, safety, health, and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Lithopolis are involved and specifically to ensure fair compensation of village employees. This Ordinance shall become effective and be in force immediately upon its passage by Council and signing by the Mayor.
