AN ORDINANCE SETTING NEW REQUIREMENTS FOR STREET PAVING AND WATER SERVICE INSTALLATION IN THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council desires to codify policy changes made by the Village Administrator to the typical sections for new road construction and water service installation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. All new roads constructed by a private entity, shall include a topcoat of Rejuvenator© within three (3) months of the final course of asphalt. Once the course of Rejuvenator© is set, the roadway can be submitted for acceptance by the Village. Roadways treated with Rejuvenator© shall only require a two (2) year maintenance bond instead of the required five (5) year maintenance bond.

Section 2. All new water service connections shall be through pit meters as specified by the Village Administrator. The Village Administrator shall develop a standard drawing for installation.

Section 3. This ordinance is to be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law. That this Ordinance is declared an emergency, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, specifically these changed need to be disseminated to builders in advance of new development. This ordinance to be in full force and effect immediately upon passage.
