AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH STRAWSER CONSTRUCTION INC FOR THE SURFACE REHABILITATION OF COLUMBUS STREET AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY;

Whereas, Village Council has determined the main street project for 2022 will be the Columbus Street Rehabilitation project, and

Whereas, the 2021 street projects were delayed until 2022 due to Covid related delays, and

Whereas, the Village will see a savings on mobilization costs to combine the 2021 street projects with the Columbus Street Rehabilitation project, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. Council approves and authorizes the Village Administrator to execute a contract with Strawser Construction Inc for the Columbus Street Rehabilitation project, attached and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare in that the village will realize a cost savings in combining the projects and the 2021 street projects are scheduled for the first half of May and shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
