An Ordinance authorizing the Village Administrator to enter into a purchase contract with the Ohio Department of Transportation for 2021-2022;

WHEREAS, Section 5513.01 (B) provides the opportunity for Counties, Townships, Municipal Corporations, Conservancy Districts, Township Park Districts, Park Districts created under Chapter 1545 of the Revised Code, Port Authorities, Regional Transit Authorities, Regional Airport Authorities, Regional Water and Sewer Districts, County Transit Boards, State Universities or Colleges to participate in contracts of the Ohio Department of Transportation for the purchase of machinery, material, supplies or other articles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. That the Village Administrator hereby requests authority in the name of the Village of Lithopolis to participate in the Ohio Department of Transportation Summer and/or Winter contracts for road salt.

Section 2. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the Village of Lithopolis to be bound by all terms and conditions as the Director of Transportation prescribes.


Section 3. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the Village of Lithopolis to directly pay vendors, under each such contract of the Ohio Department of Transportation in which the Village of Lithopolis participates, for items it receives pursuant to the contract.

Section 4. That the Village of Lithopolis agrees to be responsible for resolving all claims or disputes arising out of its participation in the cooperative purchasing program under Section 5513.01(B) of the Ohio Revised Code. The Village of Lithopolis agrees to waive any claims, actions, expenses, or other damages arising out of its participation in the cooperative purchasing program which the Village of Lithopolis may have or claim to have against ODOT or its employees, unless such liability is the result of negligence on the part of ODOT or its employees.


Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
