Sponsor Councilmember Belek Ordinance No. 11-22 Date Passed June 14, 2022

An Ordinance adopting and authorizing an increase in the Village Income Tax Rate from one percent to one and one-half percent (1% to 1.5%);

Whereas, Village Council has determined through Resolution 06-22 there is a need for additional revenue to increase police protection in the village, and

Whereas, Village Council, after deliberation, has determined that an increase in the Village Income Tax of one-half of one percent (.5%) for five (5) years is sufficient to meet this goal, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. Council adopts and authorizes an increase of one-half of one percent (.5%) to the Village's current Income Tax levied in accordance with Ordinance 03-89 and such increase shall be collected and administered in accordance with said ordinance.

Section 2. The current one percent (1%) shall be deposited in the Village General Fund and used for all purposes allowed by law.

Section 3. The new one-half of one percent (.5%) shall be used solely for the operations of the Lithopolis Police Department;

Section 4. The Village shall collect the additional one-half of one percent (.5%) from January 1, 2023, to December 31, 2027.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
