**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A 1099 CONTRACT TO PROVIDE THE DUTIES OF FISCAL OFFICER DURING THE SEARCH FOR AND TRANSITION TO A NEW FISCAL OFFICER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**Whereas**, the current Fiscal Officer, Dustin Camden, has tendered his resignation, and

**Whereas**, Mr. Camden has agreed to work on a 1099 contract, after normal business hours during the transition to a new Fiscal Officer, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;**

**Section 1.** Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute a 1099 contract for Mr. Camden's services as a contract Fiscal Officer during the transition to a new Fiscal Officer.

**Section 2.** The length of the 1099 contract shall not exceed 60 (sixty) days.

**Section 3.** This Ordinance is declared an emergency, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, specifically that the Village requires a Fiscal Officer in place to pay invoices and receive revenue into the UAN system and will be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and signing by the Mayor.
