## AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND APPROVING A 2022 SUPPLEMENTAL REVENUE INCREASE AND APPROPRIATIONS BUDGET FOR THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS.

Whereas, the Village is required to make Appropriations for Fiscal Year 2022, and

Whereas, the Village may adjust up or down appropriations as necessary to meet its financial obligations, and

Whereas, the Village may increase revenue for line items as new revenue comes in, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

**Section 1.** Council hereby adopts and approves this Revenue Increase and Supplemental Appropriations for Fiscal Year 2022.

**Section 2.** Council hereby increases the revenue available in Fund 5201-842 Sewer New Connection Capacity Charge by \$100,000 from new home construction New Community Connection Charges.

**Section 3.** Council hereby increases the appropriation in line items –

5101-539-393-0000 Motor Vehicles  
By \$35,000 from \$19,609.79 to \$54,609.79 from unappropriated revenue

5101-539-320-0000 Communications, Printing and Advertising  
By \$2,000 from \$5,000 to \$7,000 from unappropriated revenue

5101-531-211-0000 OPERS  
By \$3,000 from \$15,577.93 to \$18,577.93 from unappropriated revenue

1000-110-550-0000 Police Motor Vehicles  
By \$2,500 from \$27,000 to \$29,500 from unappropriated revenue

1000-110-221-000 Police Health Insurance  
By \$5,500 from \$21,000 to \$26,500 from unappropriated revenue

**Section 4.** Council directs the Fiscal Officer to forward this Supplemental Appropriation to the Fairfield County Auditor.

**Section 5.** This ordinance, being an appropriation for the expenses of the municipal corporation, shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and signing by the Mayor.
