AN ORDINANCE PERMITTING THE USE OF VILLAGE SIDEWALKS AND RIGHT OF WAYS FOR CAFE AND NON-PERMANENT AMENITIES.

WHEREAS, Council desires the administration to develop rules and regulations for the use of village sidewalks and right of ways for commercial café and non-permanent amenities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. The Mayor and Village Administrator shall develop Standards, Rules and Regulations to allow businesses in the Historical Business District to utilize sidewalks and public right of ways for café and non-permanent amenities.

Section 2. The application fee for a permit for commercial uses shall be \$150.00 with a \$50.00 annual renewal and the application fee for private amenities shall be a one-time fee of \$25.00.

Section 3. This ordinance is to be in full force and effect at the earliest date provided by law.
