**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF A DUMP TRUCK WITH SNOW PLOW AND SALT SPREADER WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY;**

**Whereas**, the Village is responsible for maintaining the streets within the corporation limits, and

**Whereas**, one of the snow plow trucks has reached the end of its useful life, and

**Whereas**, the loss of the snow plow truck would leave the village without the ability to maintain the village streets, and

**Whereas**, it is estimated to take approximately twenty weeks to bid, award and receive a new truck, and

**Whereas**, the Village Administrator has attempted to find alternate commercial means to provide such services in the event the current truck fails and being unable to find a cost-effective means;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;**

**Section 1.** The Council of the Village of Lithopolis has determined that it is necessary to purchase said vehicle without competitive bid.

**Section 2.** The Village Administrator is hereby directed to make written contract with Ricent Municipal to secure a vehicle that meets the specifications and needs of the village. Truck

**Section 3.** The cost of the vehicle shall not exceed one hundred twenty thousand \$120,000 ~~eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000)~~, ~~be for a term not less than 3 nor more than 5 years and be paid from the General Fund.~~

**Section 4.** This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure in that the public peace, safety, health and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Lithopolis are involved and Council declares that a real and present emergency exists in that without a truck capable of road service the village will be unable to keep the streets clear and safe.
