POLICE BLOTTER-August 2024

On August 2, police responded to the report of a domestic disturbance. A family member staying at the residence was in a dispute with the property owner, who wanted him removed from the residence. It was explained to him that, due to the relative establishing residency, officers could not force the relative to leave. He was given information on how to file for an eviction and the family member left the residence for the evening.

On August 6, police responded to a domestic disturbance. It was determined that two children in the home got into a fight over a cell phone. There was no evidence of a physical altercation, and all parties were advised.

On August 8, police responded to a domestic disturbance at the same residence. An adult female claimed that her mother struck her and pulled her hair during an argument. The mother admitted to her actions and stated she would continue to do so. She was arrested for domestic violence and transported to jail.

On August 8, an officer received a Flock camera notification of a wanted person. The officer initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle. The arresting agency declined to extradite the individual but was discovered to have a suspended license. He was cited and his vehicle was impounded.

On August 16, police assisted deputies over a road rage incident in which a gun was involved. Police and deputies located and stopped the suspect vehicle, and the driver was detained along with a handgun.

On August 21, a resident reported that a former employee had altered a business check. Police are currently working with the bank on the investigation.

On August 23, police, deputies, and paramedics were dispatched to locate an elderly woman with dementia who had wandered away from home. The woman was located in the back yard of a residence approximately a mile from her home. Due to conditions in the home, Adult Protective Services was notified.

On August 25, an officer was flagged down regarding a possible impaired driver. After observing the vehicle, the officer conducted a traffic stop and determined the driver was under the influence of alcohol. She was arrested and her BAC was .192.

On August 28, an officer observed a suspicious vehicle in a construction area. One of the occupants had an active warrant and was placed under arrest.
