AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PLAN, ATTACHED AND INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council desires to promote a sound overall development strategy that promotes and protects the village, and

WHEREAS, Council believes these goals and objectives are furthered by an official guiding document, and

WHEREAS, an Economic Development Plan ensures that residents and developers alike are aware of Council's goals and objectives, and

WHEREAS, the Revised Code requires such planning to implement certain incentive districts, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LITHOPOLIS, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO;

SECTION 1. The Economic Development Plan, attached and incorporated herein, is hereby adopted and approved.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure in that the public peace, safety, health and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Lithopolis are involved and specifically to establish goals and polices in respect to economic development and to comply with sections of the Revised Code that require an Economic Development Plan. This Ordinance shall become effective and be in force immediately upon its passage by Council and signing by the Mayor.
